





## COUNTY NEWS

### McHENRY

Over the last year, Brian Lingner of Cary, Illinios has pannelled, tiled and installed a ceiling and lighting in his basement railroad room as the correct beginning for a large model railroad. Benchwork will begin this fall on what will soon become Brians version of the Illinios Central Gulf from Homewood to south of the Kankakee River. The 200 ft. mainline will serve several interchanges with neighboring railroads as does the prototype. Markham yard will be modeled in a compressed form and the interlocking at Kankakee will add operating interest to the south end of the railroad. Trains moving north from Markham and south from Kankakee will enter an eight track hidden staging yard to achieve the "beyond the basement" feel. Walk around throttles will allow operating crews to stay with their trains as they proceed along the line.


Brian has extensively researched the prototype, even to obtaining chief engineer's drawings, planned the layout carefully and is commited to constructing a great layout, one we all can look foward to visiting in the future.

John Pautz of McHenry is well known to the FOX VALLEY DIVISION members as an active division supporter and as one of the areas '0' scale modelers. John has been making some changes lately, he still is working 'a" to the foot but the rails got closer together, 3' apart to be exact. John didn't just add On3 to his layout, he tore the old one out and completely and has reinstalled two levels of benchwork to achieve a 320' mainline run.

John will have about 600' of hand laid track and will be excellently crafted for super operation as like his previous efforts. The era will be 1920 and many smooth running steam loco's will be employed to move the tonage over the line. The model will be loosely patterned after the South Coast Railway, altho the locos and cars may have a D&RGW look.

Progress on the layout is well underway at this writing and John feels he will be operating on portions of the layout before Christmas.

### KANE

This month's club profile is on the "Midwest Railroad Modelers" of Batavia, Illinois. The era modeled is the 1940's and 50's. Five charter members founded this club in the fall of 1975. Layout construction began on the empire in January 1977 with the first loop being completed about six months later. The layout is now about 75 % completed leaving only one major town and a passenger terminal to be finished. Which won't take long the way these fellows work. They're a real dedicated group of modelers.

As the club name intamates, the setting for this pike is the Midwest. There is not a single mountain on the entire layout; which could best be described as a multi-folded dog bone with several spurs

The available space is completely filled in an example of good planning and efficent use of space. The total yard capacity is 1200 cars! Very efficiant localization and seperation of the twisting turning trackage is accomplished by a high continuous scenery divider which follows the main line around the layout.


The club is located at 14 E. Wilson, in Batavia, Il. Above a drug store in an old lodge hall of about 40x50 feet. One super feature is that there is a balcony which gives a complete overall view of the whole layout.

Since It's founding the club's membership has grown to 30+ members. New members will be considered on a individual basis.




The division has many benifits and activities for it's members. Let's particapate and help out where we can. We can allhelp each other to enjoy the great hobby of Model Railroading.


