Superintendent's Report


Ireceived a pleasant surprise in the mail this week. An envelope was sent to me by Al Potts, who is the region achievement program coordinator. Inside were three certificates for Golden Spike Awards to Chas Hague, Dave Hamilton and myself. The Golden Spike Awards are designed for people who might not have time right now to pursue the Master Model Railroader Program but who have built an operating layout or module.

To qualify, a model railroader must have built six pieces of rolling stock (detailed commercial, craftsman or scratchbuilt kits). Construct at least eight square feet of layout and five structures (detailed commercial, craftsman or scratchbuilt). Install three types of trackage and provide for simultaneous control of two trains. You should have one additional electrical feature such as powered turnouts or signalling.

The Golden Spike Award is an achievement well within the reach of the average modeler and is the NMRA's way of recognizing our efforts. If you are interested, contact any of your division officers and they will be happy to assist you with the paperwork
